REFLECTION QUESTIONS:


These questions aren't a 'test', they are meant to help you think about the passage in a different way. Don't worry if you don't have any ideas about how to respond to them right away. Sometimes we might think and pray about a passage for a while before 'the penny drops' about something.

1. The exact number of fish caught is recorded in John's Gospel; 153. This is a very specific number.

Sometimes it is important to count our blessings. Try listing things you are thankful to God for here or in a journal:

2. As Jesus shares breakfast with His disciples, he takes bread and passes it around. This is a reminder to the disciples of everything Jesus told them at the Last Supper - that His body would be broken for them.

Why do you think Jesus keeps using the image of broken bread with His disciples before and after His death/resurrection?
