1. Is a Christian who has a deep mature biblical faith, regular in church worship and personal prayer, and maintains a good standing with the local church and the wider community.
2. Has a passion to share the Christian faith with children and their families, and enjoys building relationships with children, parents, and volunteers.
3. Has experience working with children and/or families in a church, school, or community setting.
4. Is a good and reliable team player with strong communication and organisational skills.
5. Is able to build a strong rapport with children.
6. Is capable of working alongside and developing our existing children's work teams.
7. Is flexible with working hours - a regular working week will include 3 out of 4 Sunday mornings, and daytime commitments on 3 days per week including Friday evenings.
8. Is self-motivated and can work independently. Office space will be available at All Saints although some element of working from home will also be necessary.
9. Is capable of independent transport in the Marcham/Abingdon area.
10. Has a good standard of written English (email, writing letters etc.) and fluency in spoken English (public-speaking, presentations).
11. Basic ICT Capabilities i.e. proficiency with email, the internet and producing documents; willingness to use social media for publicity.
12. Flexibility and willingness to learn, to try out new ideas and types of ministry, and to participate in appropriate continuing professional development.
